

## **Abseiling and Vertical Rescue** **Instructors Course**

### **Pre-Requisites Skills And/Or Qualifications**

The course is targeted at experienced participants who aim to learn the necessary skills to become an abseiling instructor and/or improvised vertical rescue skills.

It is desirable that course applicants have a roping background in abseiling, canyoning and/or top roped rock climbing.

Students are enrolled into a **TAFE NSW Statement of Attainment in Outdoor Recreation.**

All training and assessment will be undertaken in the upper Blue Mountains.

### **Units**

The national units of competence from the Outdoor Recreation Training package covered in this course are:

#### **Abseiling Single Pitch Natural Surfaces**

**SROABN001A - demonstrate simple abseiling skills on natural surfaces**

**SROABN003A - apply single pitch abseiling skills on natural surfaces**

**SROABN004A - establish ropes for single pitch abseiling on natural surfaces**

**SROABN008A - instruct abseiling activities on natural surfaces (single pitch)**

#### **Vertical Rescue**

**SROVTR001A - perform vertical rescues**
